On the 1870 census⁷, his birthplace is listed as “Olminster land”, with “Prussia” written in large letters over that.

Henry Rupiper and family emigrated to America about 1845 and settled near Dubuque, IA.¹

The 1870 census shows “Wm” Rupiper living on a farm in Colony, Delaware County, IA with his wife and three of his children. Their family is listed as sharing a household with the family of Wm Bohunkamp, who owns the farm. They are all listed together as one family. Mrs. Bohunkamp is named Gertrude, perhaps Heinrich William’s younger sister, but I have no other record showing she married a man by that name. Perhaps the two families aren’t related at all, and the Rupipers were just renting.⁶

The Wm Rupiper family is actually listed twice on the 1870 census, both times in Colony, Delaware County, IA; once at dwelling 239 on July 12, and once at dwelling number 264 on July 13. The census taker is the same. In both cases, William is listed as Wm at both places. His wife is listed as Catherina in one case, and as Mary in the other. Ages of the two adults vary slightly between the listings, but the three children are the same in both cases: Wm, age 22; Mary, age 17; and Antoinette, age 14.⁷

On 7 May 1837 when Heinrich Wilhelm was 26, he married **Maria Catharina Hoeverer**^{1,2,3,5,6,7,8,9,10,11} in Suderwich, Westfalen, Prussia.¹ Born on 8 Mar 1812 in Germany.¹ Maria Catharina died in Feb 1895; she was 82.¹ Buried in Saint Boniface Cemetery, New Vienna, Dubuque County, IA.¹⁰ Occupation: 1870: Keeping House.⁶

The 1910 census shows John and Elizabeth Rupiper and three daughters living on a farm in Precinct 3, Cedar County, NE.²²

On 18 May 1918, John and Elizabeth were killed by a tornado, the worst in the history of Cedar County, IA. Their double funeral was held at the church in Constance, IA, and the crowd was so large only a third of the mourners could fit inside the building. Three of their daughters were badly injured in the storm, one dying from her injuries.¹

William (or Wilhelm) Rupiper grew up on a farm near New Vienna, IA and attended school there. After he had acquired the necessary education and received First Holy Communion, he took up farming and worked for his father on his parents' farm until he was 21.²⁸

William's father died in 1885, and three years later he, his wife, children, and elderly mother moved to Roselle Township, Carroll County, IA, where he purchased a 280-acre farm. He later purchased an additional 40 acres, so by 1899 he owned 320 acres total. The farm was notable for its fine location and good buildings. William and his family were highly respected and popular among all their acquaintances.²⁹

On the first page, the listings for William and Anna and possibly their two eldest sons are illegible because of a bad scan of the census form on the HeritageQuest web site. On the second page, the listings of children Frank through Aloisius are clearly readable. Anna's nephew Herman Riesberg is also living with the family.

The 1910 census shows William and Anna Rupiper living on a farm in Roselle Township, Carroll County, IA, with sons Joseph and Louis. Also residing in the household are daughter Kate, her husband Henry Steffes, and their son John Steffes.³²

The 1920 census shows William and Anna Rupiper living on a farm in Roselle Township, Carroll County, IA, with son Aloisius and his wife Carrie. Also residing in the household is Henry Meier, a 21-year-old hired farm laborer.³³

In 1923, William's mailing address is route 4, Carroll, Carroll County, IA. He is the owner of 160 acres in section 16 of Roselle Township, and 80 acres in section 17. This farm was also the home of his son Aloisius and his wife Carrie.³⁴

William and Mary Ann Riesburg had 11 children.³⁵
