**1. Julius W. Rupiper**<sup>1,2,3,4,5,6,7,8,9,10,11,12,13,14,15,16</sup>. Born on 12 Jul 1833 in Prussia.<sup>17</sup> Julius W. died in De Pere, Brown County, WI, on 22 Oct 1911; he was 78.<sup>17</sup> Buried in Mt. Calvary Cemetery, De Pere, Brown County, WI.<sup>11</sup> Occupation: 1860: cooper, 1870: carpenter, 1880: laborer; 1900: carpenter; 1910: Own income; millwright.

Alternate birthdate: 1836<sup>6</sup>

Alternate wedding date: 10 Apr 1856<sup>11</sup>

Immigrated to America 1846<sup>6</sup> or 1847.

From an article on the 50th Wedding Anniversary of Julius and Henrietta Rupiper (Waterford Post, 1906): "Mr. and Mrs. Julius Rupiper who celebrated their golden wedding at De Pere, were born in Germany a few townships apart, but from early childhood lived in the same place and were playmates together, until Mr. Rupiper with his parents emigrated to America in his twelfth year. Mrs. Rupiper, whose maiden name is Henrietta Alby, came to this country with her parents one year later, also in her twelfth year. Mr. Rupiper is now 73 years old. Mr. Rupiper's parents settled in Cincinnati, OH, after a few years moving to Milwaukee, WI. Mr. Alby settled on a farm four miles from the village of Waterford, Racine County, WI. In 1850 Mr. Rupiper's parents moved to the village of Waterford. There he met his former playmate, the liking he had for her soon ripened into love and they were married in Burlington, WI, seven miles from Waterford, on April 8, 1856, there being no Catholic church at the latter named place at that time. Ten children were born to them, four boys and six girls, nine of whom are still living. . . . Mr. Rupiper is supervisor of the Fourth ward, De Pere, which office he has held since 1894. He is president of the West De Pere school board, and for several years was alderman."<sup>10</sup>

Married Henrietta Alby about 1856. In 1860 they lived with his father in Waterford, Racine County, WI. By 1880 they had moved to De Pere.

In the 1860s operated a hotel in the Schaub building in Waterford, WI. The building was owned by Wenzell Drayhorse. Julius rented it. This building eventually became known as the Fox River Hotel, although I don't know if that's what it was called during Julius's tenure.<sup>7</sup>

Julius's obituary says he came to America at the age of 11, settled in Cincinnati, then Waterford, then moved to West De Pere, WI in 1874, where he lived the rest of his life. It states his occupation as millwright.<sup>11</sup>

Burlington Standard reported 13 Jan. 1883 that Julius, Henrietta, and Julius Jr. moved to De Pere.

By 1880 the Rupipers were already living in De Pere. The 1880 census shows Julius, Henrietta, and seven of the Rupiper children living on Eighth St. in West De Pere. Daughter Louisa Rupiper was living two houses down with her husband Joseph Sanders.<sup>7</sup>

The 1910 census shows Julius and Henrietta living alone on N. Eighth St., De Pere, WI.<sup>7</sup>

In De Pere, Julius served as alderman for several years, and was a member of the Board of Education of School District No. 2. He represented his ward on the County Board of Supervisors from 1894 until his death.<sup>11</sup>

Julius was a charter member of the German Benevolent Society in De Pere, WI.<sup>11</sup>

On 8 Apr 1856 when Julius W. was 22, he married **Henrietta (Maria Gertrude) Alby**<sup>1,2,3,4,5,18,19,7,8,10,11,20,12,13,14,16</sup> in

Burlington, Racine County, WI.<sup>1</sup> Born on 23 Aug 1834 in Recklinghausen, Westfalen, Prussia.<sup>10</sup> Henrietta (Maria Gertrude) died on 18 Aug 1916; she was 81.<sup>1</sup> Buried in Mt. Calvary Cemetery, DePere, Brown County, WI.<sup>11</sup> Occupation: 1870: keeping house; 1880: Keeping house.

Born on 18 Mar 1857 in Waterford, Racine County, WI.<sup>2</sup> Anna Maria Louisa died in West DePere, Brown County, WI, on 30 Jun 1932; she was 75.<sup>22,10</sup> Buried in Mt. Calvary Cemetery, DePere, Brown County, WI.<sup>14</sup> Occupation: 1880: Keeping house.

Alternate spelling: Louisa M.<sup>13</sup>, Louisa A.<sup>3</sup>, Louise<sup>9</sup> (Shown as Louisa on most records.)

The 1900 census states she bore 11 children, with 10 surviving. There must have been one that was already grown and left the home.<sup>23</sup>

The 1910 census says she bore 11 children, with 9 surviving. Daughter Anna is the one that's missing.<sup>24</sup>

Living in De Pere, WI at the time of father's death (1911).<sup>11</sup>

On 5 Nov 1878 when Anna Maria Louisa was 21, she married **Joseph W. Sanders**<sup>18,21,22,23,24,25,26,27,10,28,29,30,31</sup> in De Pere, Brown County, WI.<sup>10</sup> Born on 10 May 1854 in Waterford, Racine County, WI.<sup>26,20</sup> Joseph W. died in De Pere, Brown County, WI, in 1944; he was 89.<sup>26</sup> Buried in Mt. Calvary Cemetery, De Pere, Brown County, WI.<sup>25</sup> Occupation: 1880: Cooper; 1900: Laborer, Brick Yard; 1910: Section laborer, Railroad; 1920: Section man, railroad.

**3. Julius Rupiper Jr.**<sup>1,31,3,5,6,18,32,33,30,34,35</sup> Born on 15 Nov 1858 in Waterford, Racine County, WI.<sup>18,10</sup> Julius died in De Pere, Brown County, WI, on 1 Jul 1912; he was 53.<sup>10</sup> Occupation: 1880: Cooper; 1900: Saloonkeeper; 1910: merchant at a saloon.

Alternate spelling: Jules<sup>32</sup>, Julius Cesar Henry Rupiper<sup>6</sup>, Jule<sup>10</sup>

Alternate birthdate: 15 Nov 1859<sup>10</sup>

The 1880 census shows newlyweds Julius and Mary living on Oneida St. in West DePere, Brown County, WI. Julius's occupation is listed as "Cooper". However, under "number of months this person has been unemployed during the current year", it says three.<sup>34</sup>

Burlington Standard reported 13 Jan. 1883 that Julius, Henrietta, and Julius Jr. moved to De Pere.<sup>7</sup>

1900 census shows him and his family living on South Broadway, DePere, WI. It erroneously lists his parents as being French Canadian. His birthdate is listed as Jun 1857.<sup>32</sup>

Living in De Pere, WI at the time of father's death (1911).<sup>11</sup>

Julius was a member of the Brown County board at the time of his death.<sup>33</sup>

Julius died from injuries he received in an accident with a runaway horse. The horse took fright and ran down a hill toward the river. Julius and Mary were thrown onto the railroad tracks. Julius suffered a fractured skull, and Mary's arm was broken in two places.<sup>33</sup>

On 25 Nov 1879 when Julius was 21, he married **Mary Rooney**<sup>31,6,18,32,33,35,10,34</sup> in De Pere, Brown County, WI.<sup>10</sup> Born in Apr 1860 in Canada - French.<sup>32</sup> Occupation: 1880: Keeping house.

The 1880 census shows "Gusta" Rupiper living in the household of Henry Collette, for whom she is working as a servant. Collette is listed as the owner of a saw mill. He had a wife and three children. They lived on Main St. in West De Pere.<sup>9</sup>

The 1910 census states she bore 9 children, all surviving. All are shown living in the household.<sup>36</sup>

Living in De Pere, WI at the time of father's death (1911).<sup>11</sup>

Abt 1885 when Augusta was 23, she married **George S. Grover**<sup>18,22,36,37,38,10,40,11,36</sup> Born in 1861 in Afton, Union County, IA.<sup>10,36</sup> George S. died in De Pere, Brown County, WI, in 1947; he was 86.<sup>10</sup> Occupation: 1910: Carpenter, house; 1920: Carpenter, house.

The 1900 census shows Mina Robertson, widowed, living on 9th St. in De Pere, Brown County, WI. The census states she bore 7 children, with 7 surviving. All are living with her in 1900.<sup>41</sup>

The 1910 census shows Wilhelmina and family still living on 9th St. in De Pere. Sons William and Julius have moved out of the house; 5 children remain.<sup>2</sup>

Wilhelmina married **James Robertson**<sup>18,10,43,44</sup>. Born in 1858.<sup>10</sup> James died in 1893; he was 35.<sup>10</sup>

Born on 2 Aug 1866 in Waterford, Racine County, WI.<sup>12</sup> Ida Johanna Maria died in De Pere, Brown County, WI, on 26 Apr 1947; she was 80.<sup>10</sup> Occupation: 1900: dress maker; 1930: Agent, fire insurance company.

Alternate spelling: Eda

Alternate birthdate: 2 Sep 1866<sup>10</sup>, 2 Aug 1865<sup>18</sup>

Alternate death date: 26 Apr 1948<sup>18</sup>

In 1900 she is single and living with her father and mother.

According to the 1910 census, Viola was her only child.<sup>17</sup>

Living in De Pere, WI at the time of father's death (1911).<sup>11</sup>

In 1930, Mrs. Ida Janssen was the census taker for the 4th Ward of DePere, including her own census record, source<sup>18</sup>. The 1930 census shows her living at 244 N. 6th St. in West DePere, widowed, with her daughter Viola. The value of her home is listed as \$3,000. She is sharing her dwelling with a pair of renters, husband and wife Henry and Bertha Dorns [name is difficult to read]. They are in their mid-60s. Henry is Wisconsin-born to Welsh parents. He works at a paper mill. Bertha is a native of Denmark. They are renting space from Ida for \$12.00 a month.<sup>18</sup>

Coincidentally, Ida is living next door to a Henry Janssen, not her dead husband, 69 years old with a wife Hattie and son Adolph. <sup>18</sup>

On 7 Jan 1902 when Ida Johanna Maria was 35, she married **Henry J. (Duke) Janssen**<sup>10,51,45,52,18,47,48,49,53,10,17,11,12</sup> in Brown County, WI. Born on 6 Nov 1876 in West De Pere, Brown County, WI.<sup>12</sup> Henry J. (Duke) died on 4 Apr 1922; he was 45.<sup>10</sup> Occupation: 1880: Clerk; 1910: Insurance agent; 1920: [occupation illegible].

Born on 18 Oct 1867 in Waterford, Racine County, WI.<sup>10</sup> William A. died in De Pere, Brown County, WI, on 17 Dec 1944; he was 77.<sup>10</sup> Buried in Mt. Calvary Cemetery, De Pere, Brown County, WI.<sup>12</sup> Occupation: 1880: Filer, saw mill; 1910: machinist at a boat factory; 1920: [occupation illegible]; 1930: Mechanic, garage.

1870 census lists age as 5. 1910 census lists age as 42, which would make birth date about about 1868.

The 1940 census states he completed an 8th grade education.<sup>62</sup>

Married Annie Janssen about 1895. In 1910 they lived with his brother Rudolph and wife Minnie, and her brother William Janssen, on N. 8th St. in De Pere, WI.

The 1900 census shows William Rupiper and Anna Janssen living on North 8th St. in De Pere, WI. They have no children. They are living a few houses down the street from her parents and siblings.<sup>63</sup>

Living in De Pere, WI at the time of father's death (1911).<sup>11</sup>

The 1920 census shows William and Annie Rupiper living on Main Ave. in De Pere, WI.<sup>64</sup>

1930 census shows William and Annie Rupiper living on Main Ave. in DePere (house number is illegible). The value of the family home is listed as \$10,000 (quite a lot for that time). Also living with the couple are Annie's mother Minnie (my great-great grandmother), nephew James Janssen (not sure whose child he is), and a 23-year-old servant, Esther Zitzman. At this time William is working as a mechanic in a garage, with Annie keeping books for the garage.<sup>65</sup>

The memorial card from his funeral states that he "owned a garage in West De Pere."<sup>66</sup>

That garage was called "Rupiper Garage".<sup>10</sup>

After William died, his nephews Ben and Joe Sanders took over the garage and ran it for a few years.<sup>67</sup>

The 1940 census shows William and Anna Rupiper living at 511 Main St. in De Pere, Brown County, WI. William owns the home, worth \$4,000.00. Neither of them is working. They also have a servant living in the home, 32-year-old Viola Sanders. She is the first cousin, once removed of Anna Janssen.<sup>62</sup>

On 16 Oct 1894 when William A. was 26, he married **Anna (Annie) Janssen**<sup>14,50,51,55,52,18,56,22,57,49,58,59,10,60,61,17,12,62, 60</sup> Born on 4 Oct 1872 in Freedom, Outagamie County, WI.<sup>22</sup> Anna (Annie) died on 2 Jun 1946; she was 73.<sup>22</sup> Buried in Mt. Calvary Cemetery, De Pere, Brown County, WI.<sup>22</sup> Occupation: 1930: Bookkeeper, garage.

**8. Maria Sophia Elizabeth Rupiper**<sup>1,18,63,64,65,7,10,17,11,20</sup> Born on 1 Feb 1870 in Waterford, Racine County, WI.<sup>10</sup> Maria Sophia Elizabeth died in Green Bay, Brown County, WI, in 1961; she was 90.<sup>10</sup> Occupation: 1910: Household Duties.

Alternate spelling: Sophie<sup>68</sup>

The 1870 census shows a 5-month-old Sophia Rupiper living in Waterford, WI, not with her parents but with the next-door neighbors, Joseph and Mary Kortendick.<sup>1</sup>

Living in Green Bay, WI at the time of father's death (1911).<sup>11</sup>

Living in Green Bay, WI at the time of William Janssen's death (1916). She attended the funeral in De Pere, WI.<sup>17</sup>

Living in Green Bay, WI at the time of Henrietta Alby's death (1916). She and her husband attended the funeral in De Pere, WI.<sup>60</sup>

1920 census lists her parents' birthplace as "Westphalia".<sup>65</sup>

The 1900 and 1910 censuses state she bore three children, with all three surviving.<sup>65</sup>

On 6 Aug 1887 when Maria Sophia Elizabeth was 17, she married **George Barth**<sup>18,63,64,65,10,17,11,20, 10</sup> Born in 1868 in WI.<sup>10,63</sup> George died in 1940; he was 72.<sup>18</sup> Occupation: 1900: Cigar Maker; 1910: Cigar Maker; 1920: Manufacturer, Cigars.

Her obituary includes the nickname Mate in parentheses; its pronunciation is unclear.<sup>57</sup>

She was a lifelong member of St. Boniface Church in West De Pere. She sang in the church choir for over 50 years, and was a member of the Christian Mothers.<sup>57</sup>

Living in De Pere, WI at the time of father's death (1911).<sup>11</sup>

Last residence: 806 Third St., West De Pere, WI 54115<sup>57</sup>

On 24 Oct 1899 when Mary Margaret (Mate) was 24, she married **Jacob Janssen**<sup>46,67,68,69,4,50,72,51,52,18,70,22,57,71,69,10,61,17,11,12,13</sup> in De Pere, WI. Born on 29 May 1875 in De Pere, Brown County, WI. Jacob died in Ashwaubenon, Brown County, WI, on 5 Dec 1940; he was 65.<sup>22,57</sup> Buried on 9 Dec 1940 in Mt. Calvary Cemetery, De Pere, Brown County, WI.<sup>57</sup> Occupation: 1900: teamster?; 1910: machinist, paper mill; 1920 & 1930: superintendent, Brown County Work House.

Born on 16 Sep 1878 in De Pere, Brown County, WI.<sup>22,10</sup> Joseph Friedrich Rudolph died on 6 Jan 1955; he was 76.<sup>22</sup> Occupation: 1900: carpenter, 1910: pattern maker at a foundry; 1920: Contractor, houses; 1930: Cabinet maker, lumber yard; 1940: Proprietor, Retail lumber yard.

Alternate name: Rudolf<sup>3</sup>, Joseph R.<sup>7</sup>

In 1900 he is single and living with his father and mother.

The 1940 census states that Rudolph completed one year of high school.<sup>28</sup>

Married Minnie ? about 1901. In 1910 they were living with his brother William, wife Annie, and William Janssen (brother of Annie Janssen) on N. 8th St., De Pere, WI.

Living in De Pere, WI at the time of father's death (1911).<sup>11</sup>

The 1920 census shows Rudolph and Wilhelmina Rupiper sharing a household with his sister Ida and brother-in-law Henry Janssen on Eighth St. in De Pere.<sup>24</sup>

In 1930 William and Wilhelmina lived at 444 Grant St. in DePere. The value of their home was listed as \$6,000. Also living with the couple is Ann Baeten, listed as mother-in-law. I'm not sure why she does not have the same last name as her daughter, unless perhaps she was married a second time.<sup>24</sup>

The 1940 census shows Rudolph, wife Wilhelmina, and mother-in-law Anna Baeten residing at 444 Grant St., De Pere, Brown County, WI. Rudolph owns the home, worth \$3,900.00.<sup>25</sup>

According to the memorial card from his funeral, Rudolph was a member of the Holy Name Society of St. Boniface Church, and of St. Norbert Court COF. He is also listed as "Ex Mayor, Ex Councilman, Ex Schoolboard Member, City of DePere".<sup>22</sup>

The De Pere Journal remembered that about 30 Jun 1934 ["Fifteen Years Ago"], Mayor Rudolph Rupiper sent a list of suggested city improvements to the governor, including a new sewage disposal plant, ornamental street lighting, new public library, and an additional auditorium at the high school.<sup>26</sup>[side article]

On 27 Aug 1901 when Joseph Friedrich Rudolph was 22, he married **Wilhelmina (Minnie) Vander Zanden**<sup>73,138,48,74,221,10,75</sup> in De Pere, Brown County, WI. Born on 13 Apr 1880 in WI.<sup>22</sup> Wilhelmina (Minnie) died on 12 Sep 1967; she was 87.<sup>22</sup>

The witnesses were Edward Allen [a cousin of the bride, through the Kaye family, but I'm not sure exactly how he's related], and Marion Janssen [Auntie Mick]. Carl was listed as a resident of Ashwaubenon; Loretto of De Pere.<sup>117</sup>

Philip J. Dart and William Hughes were ushers at the wedding. "The bride was attired in a biege [sic] ensemble suit and wore an orchid picture hat and fox fur neckpiece." Dinner was served at the bride's family home at 602 S. Michigan St., De Pere, WI. Carl and Loretto then departed for a three week honeymoon to "Kenosha, Milwaukee, Chicago and eastern cities." After that, the couple will live in the Dart home.<sup>57</sup>

The 1930 census shows Carl, Loretto, Jay, and Mary Claire living at 602 S. Michigan St. in DePere. It shows that Carl owned the family home, but where the value of that home should be specified, there is only an M (for mortgage?). Also living with the family is Loretto's mother, Mary Dart, a 71-year-old widow.<sup>115</sup>

The obituary of Jewel Dart Flanigan states that she lived with Carl and Loretto from 1925 to 1948, but she does not appear with that household on the 1930 census.<sup>57</sup>

Carl began his first business at the corner of Irwin and Mason Streets in Green Bay, WI. In the early 1930s he bought the H. I. Wheeler drug store in De Pere, WI, and operated the store until he was appointed postmaster 23 Jun 1944. He held the post of postmaster until retiring in 1970.<sup>57</sup>

The De Pere Journal announced that the De Pere post office would achieve first-class status on 1 Jul 1949, due to the post office having sold over \$40,000 worth of stamps in a calendar year. Carl was interviewed and pictured in the article.<sup>56</sup>

Exactly 21 years later, the Journal announced Carl's retirement from the office of Postmaster. He had held the post longer than anyone in the history of the east De Pere post office. During his tenure, annual postal receipts rose from \$22,000 to over \$200,000. When asked about his plans after retirement, Carl said that he and Loretto planned to "take it easy for a while."<sup>118</sup>

Carl was also active in community organizations. He was commander of the Heesaker-Brown post of the American Legion and served as their chaplain for many years [from 1936 to at least 1970<sup>118</sup>]. He met every train returning bodies of World War II veterans. He was a member of the De Pere Rotary Club for 37 years and at one time served as president. He also served as the club's song leader for many years [from 1936 to at least 1970. His wife Loretto accompanied him on piano<sup>118</sup>]. He enjoyed barbershop quartet singing. He was a charter member of SPEBSQSA, the barbershopper organization, and a member of the first quartet formed under that organization, "The Note-Able 4". He was a member of the Wisconsin Association of Postmasters, past president of the Wisconsin Chapter of the National Association of Postmasters of the United States, and past exalted ruler of the Green Bay Elks Club No. 259. He was also a member of the Holy Name Society of St. Francis Xavier Church in De Pere, WI.<sup>57</sup>

He also served as chairman of the March of Dimes and Red Cross drives for several years, and worked with Boy Scouts.<sup>118</sup>

Carl had the lead role in the musical comedy "Crazy Politics", put on by the American Legion post of De Pere, WI [date unknown]. The show had a cast of more than a 100 people. The play featured either men playing women's roles or men playing men pretending to be women. I can't figure out which. There is a newspaper photo [probably
